

BEZEL

Cabernet Sauvignon 2021

92 Points

This pitch-black colored Cabernet
Sauvignon from Bezel in Paso Robles opens
with a mild ripe blackberry and oak
bouquet. On the palate, this wine is medium
plus bodied with integrated medium acidity.
The mouthfeel balanced, round and dense.
The flavor profile is a concentrated
blackberry and black currant blend with
notes of stony minerality and black tea. I
also detected some hints of loam and black
licorice. The finish is dry and its well
managed refines tannins are nicely
sustained.
